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Subject: Published Results of the AB Condo Act Team (ACAT) Sept. 2017 Provincial and Municipal feedback request re our condo related "Improvement Ideas".

Hello:

In our effort to be open and transparent, and do what we said we would do in terms of publishing the results of our recent Alberta Condo Act Team (ACAT) condominium questionnaire regarding our "Improvement Ideas", please be advised the results are now available on our website, www.albertacondominiums.ca, in the DOCUMENTS tab.

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We sent our condominium "Improvement Ideas" package to a total of one hundred and sixty-two (162) Provincial and Municipal elected representatives: 87 Provincial and 75 Municipal representatives.

We received three (3) Provincial responses out of eighty-seven (87) requests with two (2) of the three (3) requests being classified as "non-responsive responses".

Provincially, Service Alberta Minister Stephanie McLean and Associate Minister for Health Brandy Payne submitted non-responsive responses, where they responded but did not answer the questionnaire or provide their opinion on our "Improvement Ideas".

Dr. David Swann, MLA, Calgary-Mountain View, Alberta Liberal Opposition Leader, provided the one and only single credible response. Dr. Swann took specific, observable and measurable action by writing to Minister McLean in support of our condo owner advocacy work and our Improvement Ideas.

We did not receive a response from any Municipal elected representatives: seventy-five (75) individuals who play(ed) a key role in approving condominium development throughout Alberta.

One hundred and fifty-nine (159) Provincial and Municipal elected representatives did not respond to our request.

Our original September 2017 request; Dr. Swann's letter to Minister McLean; the McLean and Payne submissions; and the names of all those Provincial and Municipal elected representatives who did, or did not, respond to our request are on our website.
